This class is available to all Airport Authority employees and tenants. Class size for each training session is limited to facilitate learning, so early registration is encouraged. To avoid any no-shows, we kindly request that you send cancellation within 48 hours of the start of class should a situation arise that prohibits you from attending. All classes will be held in the Lindbergh Conference Room

Please note that classes may be cancelled should there be less than four attendees.

These classes are conducted by airport-contracted paramedics, whose primary responsibility and priority is to respond to potential or actual medical emergencies. All employees signing up for these classes must accept the possibility that a scheduled class may be delayed and/or cancelled with very short or no advanced notice due to the unavailability of instructors.
