Airport Updates:

Holiday parking procedures - Just park in the black and white permit parking, regular spaces, or Ambassador spaces. For the holiday, refrain from the 60-minute if you can. We heard they might be checking those spots. Speaking of Ambassador spaces, there are three new Ambassador spaces in the T2West/McCain parking lot. They are near the charter vehicle spots. YAY!

January and February **Sterile Badge** holders will need to renew their badges before the end of their birth month. You can renew the month before your birthday, but it must be completed by the end of your birth month. You need to make an appointment through Gina (recommended) or take your chances going standby. You will need completed Fingerprint Applications and FBI History forms (CHRC), and a Security Threat Assessment (STA) form, as well as two forms of ID (such as a current passport & driver's license). You will

be fingerprinted again, but no online test again!

Tickets & Tours

To obtain **Old Town Trolley** and **Seal Tour** passage, you must contact Gina at least 72 hours in advance with the date (two dates for Seal Tour) you wish to go. Your request will be submitted and they will try to accommodate your request. If you have already used your guest passes for the Old Town Trolley, you can download a "Hometown Pass" from their website and can accompany any paying passenger for free. Kindly note, this is not available on weekends. There are no tickets; your name is listed on the passenger manifest. **No Seal Tours on weekends and no OTT on Holiday weekends.**
