## Monthly Meeting

Our monthly meeting was in the Board Room of the Airport Administration Building. There were lots of announcements from Colm, some of which will be covered in Airport Updates. The biggest news was the moving of the Federal Inspection Service area (FIS), more commonly known as Customs. The Board will actually decide this at their meeting on March 2nd, but the plan is to start ASAP on the new area, which is going to include the existing areas of T2 West and Baggage Carousels 7 and 8. This will mean that Delta will move back into the large baggage claim area (1-6). This change is to accommodate Japan Airlines; British Airways; Condor (May); Edelweiss (June); and Alaska, American, and Southwest international flights coming in the next few months. The T2 West desk will close, but the plan is to build out a desk at T2 West Post Security, and many of the current T2 West volunteers can move up there. Stay tuned!

## Airport Updates:

**March and April Sterile Badge** holders will need to renew their badges before the end of their birth month. You can renew the month before your birthday, but it must be completed by the end of your birth month. You need to make an appointment through Gina (recommended) or take your chances going standby. You will need completed Fingerprint Application and Security Threat Assessment (STA) form and two forms of ID (a current passport or social security, or birth certificate & driver's license). All forms must be filled out online. Gina can send you the links to the forms you will need. There is also a computer and printer outside Gina's office, which you can use to fill out forms and print them. The forms are on the desktop. Code for the door is 4266#.

There is new free **WIFI** at the airport. It is easier to access, faster and you can be on for 2 hours at a time. #SANFREEWIFI, just accept terms and conditions.

**Seasonal air service** will be as follows starting April and May:

**Southwest Airlines** will begin service on April 28<sup>th</sup> to Cabo San Lucas, Indianapolis, Boise, Spokane, and Newark

**Spirit Airlines** will be going to Boise, ID

**Alaska Airlines** will be going to Baltimore and Sacramento

**Frontier Airlines** will be going to Austin, Cincinnati, and Cleveland 3 times weekly

**Mac Cosmetics** will be opening in March in Terminal 2 post security.

**Restrooms** are being updated in Terminal 2. In Terminal 1 only, there is also pilot program where complaints or needs in the restrooms can be reported by anyone with the ability to text on their smartphone. There are signs on the wall on how to text for Flagship.

**New downstairs carts** should be delivered shortly. The current ones were only leased until the new Airport ones were delivered. These new carts will be beige in color.

**Blue Book** truly does have everything you need to know. Telephone numbers for the desks and the upstairs cart are in the book. In your quiet time, please review the contents of the Blue Book. Many of the questions Gina gets or on Notes to Nancy are answered in the Blue Book. You just have to know where to look.

**Do not leave requests for supplies** on Notes to Nancy. Call Gina. Most-used supplies are available in Adrianna's office on top of the refrigerator. The code to her door is 4952#. So if we aren't there you can still get supplies. The outside door is 4266#. With those codes you have access to drinks and supplies when the Ambassador office is closed.

This class is available to all Airport Authority and tenants. Class size has a limited amount of space and we would like to prevent any no shows. If you can no longer attend, please send a cancellation within 48 hours.

Please note class may be canceled should there be less than four attendees. These classes are conducted by airport-contracted paramedics, whose primary responsibility and priority is to respond to potential or actual medical emergencies. All employees signing up for these classes must accept the possibility that a scheduled class may be delayed and/or canceled with very short or no advanced notice due to the unavailability of instructors.

### **Tickets & Tours**

To obtain **Old Town Trolley** and **Seal Tour** passage, you must contact Gina at least 72 hours in advance with the date (two dates for Seal Tour) you wish to go. Your request will be submitted and they will try to accommodate your request. If you have already used your guest passes for the Old Town Trolley, you can download a "Hometown Pass" from their website and can accompany any paying passenger for free. Kindly note, this is not available on weekends. There are no tickets; your name is listed on the passenger manifest. **No Seal Tours on weekends and no OTT on Holiday weekends.**
